What is CHBRP?


- CHBRP is an independent, analytic resource serving the California Legislature, grounded in academia and policy analysis
 - Administered by the University of California
 - Provides timely, <u>evidence-based</u> information to the Legislature
- Neutral without specific policy recommendations
- Fast 60 days or less

CHBRP'S WORKING DEFINITION

 Social determinants of health are conditions in which people are born, grow, live, work, learn, and age.
 These social determinants of health (economic factors, social factors, education, physical environment) are shaped by the distribution of money, power, and resources and are impacted by policy.
